4.19.2020... Immerse Poets – Lamentations (wk 3 of Poets reading plan)

1. Lament is defined as a passionate expression of grief or sorrow. Is there something that you are currently lamenting over?
2. Read the story of The Sinful Woman
 - a. Read Luke 7:36-50
 - b. Read the same story in a different version of the bible. (The YouVersion bible app is a great tool for this!.... download it on your smartphone or tablet)
 - c. Close your bibles. Choose 1 person from the group to retell the story with as much detail as you can remember. No pressure! The rest of the group fills in any details missed.
 - d. Open your bibles again. Read Luke 7:36-50 one more time noticing any details that were missed.
3. What does this story tell us about God's character and His plan?
4. What does this story tell us about humans?
5. Who do you see yourself as in this story and why?
6. How will you apply this story to your life?
7. Who can you tell this story to this week?
8. Commit Lamentations 3:22-24 to memory this week. "Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness. I say to myself, "The Lord is my portion; therefore I will wait for him." Meditate on these verses this week.
9. Make it a priority this week to sit quietly with God and lament over the current pandemic. What comes to mind? If comfortable share about your time with your group at your next gathering.
